# Summary of School Day Guidance

- ▶ Entrance/exit gate **Side Pedestrian (next to Canteen)**
- ▶ Start time **8:45am** (children to enter classrooms from 8.30am)
- ▶ Pick-up time **2pm**
- ▶ **Full school uniform with shirt, tie and black shoes**
- ▶ PE days are **Tuesday** and **Friday**– Children should come to school in PE uniform on these days.
- ▶ Healthy Snack-fruit/vegetables & water (no juice)
- ▶ **Please label every item of your child's uniform including coats. Please also label lunchboxes and water bottles.**
- ▶ All children will need a pair of wellington boots that can be kept in a bag on their peg. **THESE WILL NOT GO HOME.**
- ▶ Children should also bring a spare pair of clothes including underwear and socks for the beginning of the year.
- ▶ All children will need to have a waterproof coat every day for outdoor activities.

# Homework



A weekly homework message will be sent out on Seesaw on Monday.

Homework folders will be sent home on Monday and should be returned on Friday.

- ▶ Three written pieces of work-1 Literacy, 1 Numeracy and either 1 World Around Us or 1 Religion.
- ▶ Guided Reading should be completed every night (one text that has been prepared in class and another unseen extension book).
- ▶ Revision of High Frequency Words (see the list at the back of the book).  
*Please let us know when your child has learnt all these words, and we will provide the next list.*
- ▶ Phonics: We will share the sounds of the week on Seesaw.

# Language and Literacy

## Talking and Listening skills

The children will work towards:

- ▶ Following and listening to teacher instructions.
- ▶ Listening to peers when they are talking.
- ▶ Asking and answering appropriate questions.

## Reading

There will be a range of reading opportunities offered...shared, modelled and guided.

- **Shared Reading:** One big book per week/fortnight which supports talking and listening and reading opportunities.
- **Guided Reading:** Preparation of 1 reading book every week. Children will also receive an extension book for homework. This is unseen and from the reading band below.
- We encourage the children to use a range of strategies to read unfamiliar words, e.g. phonics, picture cues, syntax and context. They should also make predictions about ideas, events and characters in their stories.
- The children will work towards recognising the First 100 High Frequency Words by the end of Year 2.



# Language and Literacy



## Phonics

- ▶ In St. Michael's we following the Linguistic Phonics programme.
- **Term 1A:** Revision of initial sounds taught in Year 1 & CVC word making (segmenting) & reading (blending)
- **Term 1B:** Introduction two letters/1 sound e.g. ss, ll, th
- **Term 2-3:** Introduction of alternate ways to make 1 sound e.g. oa/oe/o-e/ow

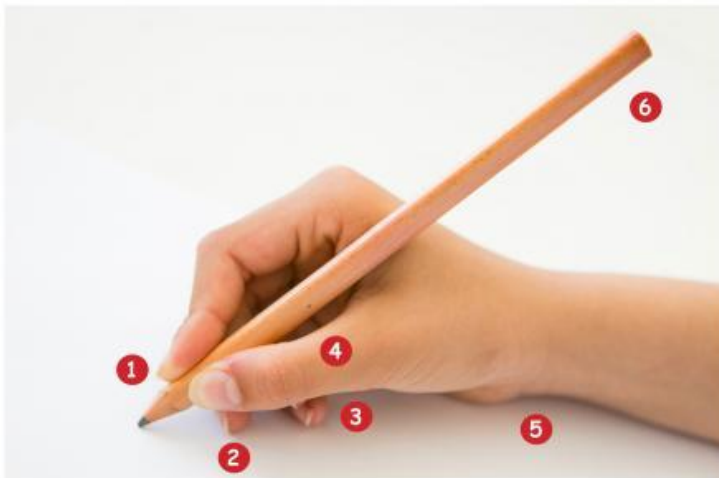
## Writing

- ▶ The children will work towards:
- Using capital letters, full stops and finger spaces.
- Writing sentences using phonics and high frequency words.
- Writing about a character/theme/topic.

## Handwriting

The children will work towards:

- Consistently employing a tripod pencil grip.
- Forming letters correctly with 'flicks and kicks'
- Using correct letter sizing



# Mathematics and Numeracy

- The children will explore Mathematics and Numeracy in the following areas:
- **Number** e.g. *Numbers to 20 and beyond, ordering, odd/even, doubles, adding & subtracting within 20.*
- **Money** e.g. *recognition of coins to 50p, sorting coins, finding different ways to make amounts to 20p, calculating change from 20p.*
- **Shape and Space** e.g. *Naming basic 2D and 3D shapes, comparing two different shapes and identifying how they are similar/different, exploring basic properties.*
- **Data Handling** e.g. *Sorting for various criteria and discussing data, sorting with Venn & Carroll diagrams, creating bar charts and pictograms.*
- **Measure** e.g. *exploring measure with non-standard units, reading simple digital and analogue clock displays to o'clock and half past.*
- **Mental Maths** e.g. *problem-solving within 20, recalling addition and subtraction facts, counting in 2s, 5s and 10s, developing mathematical language associated with adding and subtracting...more/less, plus/minus, sum, altogether, difference between etc.*
- **Processes** e.g. *discussing how they problem solved or reached their answer, using mathematical equipment for learning,*



# Learning Through Play

- ▶ The children will experience indoor and outdoor play opportunities throughout the week covering areas such as:
  - Physical
  - Sand
  - Water
  - Dough
  - Tabletop, e.g. phonics and number board games, jigsaws etc.
  - Writing
  - Creative, i.e. art, music, drama
  - Small World
  - Roleplay
  - ICT

Please remember to send in a pair of wellington boots (in a labelled bag) which can stay in school for the duration of the year.

There will also be practical play opportunities during Literacy and Numeracy lessons.



# Play Fund

In P1 & P2 we have a voluntary 'Play Fund'. With this money, teachers can provide additional materials for arts and crafts relating to specific topic art, update toys, update outdoor learning and buy cooking ingredients.

This will be much appreciated by staff and allow them to offer a wider range of interesting activities for the children. This can be paid up front, termly or weekly.

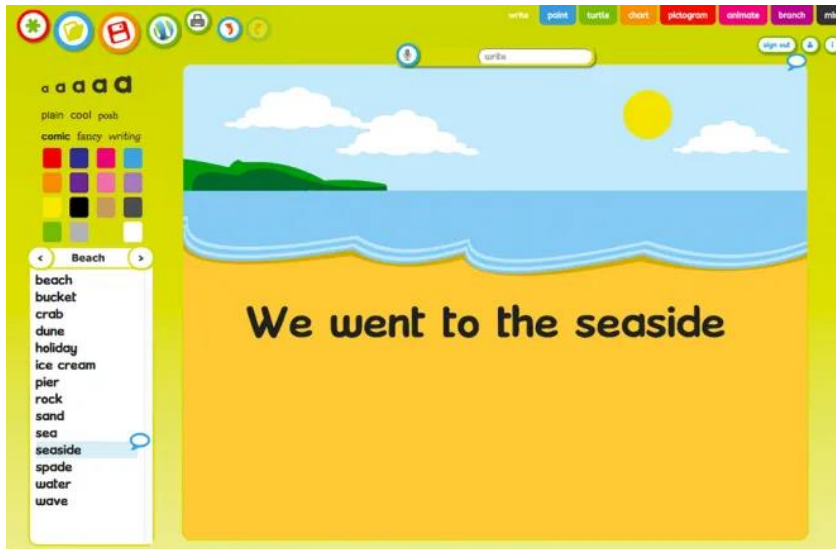
# World Around Us

- Literacy, Numeracy and Play opportunities will link to our topic work.

# ICT

- ▶ Pupils are working towards:
  - Recognising common symbols on a computer screen.
  - Using a mouse to select and carry out simple activities.
  - Using drawing tools to create a simple picture.
  - Saving and printing their work.
  - Writing a simple sentence.



# Religious Education



- We follow the Year 2 Grow in Love programme.
- The children will learn many songs throughout the year.
- The pupils will say the morning prayer, grace before meals, grace after meals and night prayer during the school day.
- Over the year, they will also learn the Glory be to the Father, Guardian Angel, Our Father and Hail Mary prayers.
